DON BOSCO TECHNICAL INSTITUTE - EMBU

Don Bosco Embu Technical Institute is situated on Kiritiri Road about 7kms from Embu Town. The school is managed by the Salesians of Don Bosco, an international Roman Catholic Organization serving the youth in 132 countries of the world. The Technical Institute is adjacent to the Technical Secondary School. The Institute is well equipped and has the following trades:

- Carpentry & Joinery
- Cabinet Making (those completed Carpentry)
- Electrical Engineering
- Masonry
- Mechanical Engineering
- Motor Vehicle Engineering
- Plumber/ Pipe Fitter

We also offer short courses in Solar Energy lasting six months.

THE DURATION OF THE COURSE

All our courses run for one year from January to December. At the end of the course the students sit for Grade III NITA Examination.

REQUIREMENT

For those applying for Carpentry & Joinery & Masonry could be Standard 8 and above. The other courses require Form IV. Both boys and girls above 17 years can apply. We have limited Boarding facility for those who are from far.

2023 INTAKE

The interviews for 2023 intake will be in the first two weeks of December 2022 and in the first two weeks of January to 15th February 2023. The time for interview is from 8am to 3pm.
